We are pleased to announce our coach outing for Wednesday 13th August 2025. This year we will be visiting the fascinating and interesting Lancashire Coal Mining Museum, near Astley Green, Wigan.

This award-winning museum offers a unique opportunity to explore the legacy of coal mining in Lancashire. Housing the last remaining headgear in the Lancashire Coal Field, the largest working pit-winding engine in Britain, a working mine railway and a replica miners cottage it is sure to be a fascinating day out.







We will also visit the nearby Leigh Spinners Mill - one of the largest mills ever building and still producing material today. The non-working half of the mill contains independent businesses, a heritage centre, café and the North West Computer Museum (additional charge will apply to visit).

Planning Matters

HMO Watch - a number of members have made us aware of their concerns over the number of Houses of Multiple Occupation (HMOs) that have sprung up in recent years.

We are currently recording the numbers of HMO applications made to Liverpool City Council however we are also aware that there are no requirements to seek planning permission for smaller HMOs. If you are aware of any HMOs please contact us at our email below so we can record them.

Picton Clock and Lockup— We have been in contact *again* with the maintenance department of the council to ask them to set the correct time on our famous Picton clock.

It has stopped and is now showing wrong times on each of the four faces.

Also we are asking for the weather vane on top of the Lock Up to be re-erected. This was broken off due to the overhanging trees.

The ongoing saga of removing the five trees causing damage to the Lock Up is also concerning

Mobile Phone Mast Objection— A proposal was submitted to planning for another mobile phone mast on Church Road. Due to its impact on the Conservation Area and existing masts the society has registered an objection to the granting of the application.
